

Welcome to Kalvsjön!

The lake is accessible for fishing during the period May 15 to September 30.

To have access to the lake for fishing a fishing license (**Fiskekort**) is requested.



The license is personal and not valid for any other than the holder.

Children under 12 years are allowed to fish without license if using the quota of a valid license (**maximum three (3) fishes**).

Fishing license must be shown upon request from any member or fishery overseer.

The license is bought in the cottage by the camping at the west side of the lake.

The fishing license fee is **240 SEK**. NOTE: **Only cash payment**.

When six fishing licenses have been purchased by the same fisher, current year, the 7th is free of charge.

Put the six “old” fishing licenses in the envelope as payment.

The license is valid during one day from 06.00 until 24.00 and entitles to three (3) fishes.

Fishing is only allowed from pier or shoreline using spinning rod or fly-fishing.

It is not allowed to use a boat, canoe or float tube/”Belly boat”.

Only one rod per person can be used.

It is forbidden to fish with baited hooks, such as worms, maggots, dough, paste, cheese or Bait, died or live bait fish.

More information about baits can be found on the signs around the lake.

It is possible to use the camping at Kalvsjön.

The camping is located on the west side of the lake.

There is limited access to electricity

The cost for camping is **50 SEK**/night per caravan, motorhome or tent.

Camping is permitted only in connection with fishing.

Please make contact with someone at the camping to be assigned location.

Take good care of nature and use the barbecue areas around the lake if you want to make fire.

The possibility of using firewood and barbecue areas applies only to fishermen, with valid fishing license.

O B S Minimum size for Brown trout is 35 cm.

Have a great fishing season!

Permissible bait

You may use: 1. Square Edge Jig

2. Spinnerbait

3. Spoon Lure

4. Wobbler

5. Fly



It is FORBIDDEN to fish with baited hooks.

Such as : 1.Worm 2.Maggot 3.Shrimp 4.Corn
5.Dough, pasta, cheese or bait 6.Died or live bait fish
